The OPSA CMCRI Nastrino Plurispécialista is a dress ribbon for rescue and assistance professionals who want a refined, professional insignia to wear on uniforms and formal attire. It represents competence and dedication with a subtle, formal appearance suited to official and ceremonial use.

- **Use:** Intended as a service/rescue ribbon to wear on uniforms, dress jackets and formal clothing.

Product overview

The Nastrino Plurispécialista OPSA CMCRI is a service ribbon issued to CMCRI personnel who have completed the Operatore Plurispécialista OPSA course organized by the Corpo Militare Croce Rossa. It is intended for uniform wear by entitled personnel and for collectors of official



ribbons and military surplus items.

Definition: a small service ribbon 10 mm high and 37 mm wide that identifies successful completion of the Operatore Plurispecialista OPSA training. Suitable for display on ribbon bars, dress uniforms and for collectors of tactical, military surplus and duty equipment.

Main features

Well-made to reflect the official look and dimensions expected for service ribbons.

- **Official size:** 10 mm high x 37 mm wide.
- **Distinctive design:** yellow background with a 2 mm horizontal red stripe and a five-point silver star centered.
- **Finish options:** standard flat regulation finish or slightly domed Elite variant.
- **Attachment choices:** rear-mounted with clamps or screws—selectable from the product options.
- **Mounting compatibility:** can be fitted on two- or multi-place metal ribbon bars for an orderly display.

How to use / When it's useful

Wear the ribbon on the service or dress uniform where regulations permit, mounted on the appropriate ribbon bar or backing. Use the flat regulation finish for standard uniform wear and consider the Elite variant for presentations or display boards.

Quick answer: wear it only if you are entitled to the qualification and follow your unit's uniform rules.

In most cases, choose the attachment type (clamps or screws) based on how you mount ribbons to your uniform or display backing.

Care and notes

Simple care keeps the ribbon presentable and preserves its mounting hardware.

- Store in a dry place and avoid prolonged exposure to sunlight to prevent fading.
- Clean gently with a soft, dry cloth; avoid solvents or abrasive cleaners.
- Select the correct finish and attachment option when ordering to match uniform rules and mounting hardware.
- Only wear the ribbon if you are authorized to do so; follow official uniform regulations.

FAQ

Q: Who can receive the Nastrino Plurispecialista OPSA CMCRI?



A: The ribbon is intended for CMCRI personnel who have completed the Operatore Plurispecialista OPSA course organized by the Corpo Militare Croce Rossa. Purchase of the ribbon does not itself confer the qualification.

Q: What are the ribbon dimensions?

A: The ribbon measures 10 mm in height and 37 mm in width, matching the stated service ribbon size.

Q: What packaging and finish options are available?

A: Available in the flat regulation finish or the slightly domed Elite variant. You can also choose rear attachments with clamps or screws from the product options.

Q: Can multiple ribbons be mounted together?

A: Yes. The ribbon can be mounted on two- or multi-place metal ribbon bars designed to hold several ribbons side by side.

Q: How do I choose the correct variant for uniform wear?

A: Check your unit or service uniform regulations for approved ribbon finish and mounting. Generally, the flat regulation format is standard for uniform wear; choose clamps or screws to match your ribbon bar.

Q: Is this ribbon an official award or a reproduction for collectors?

A: The item is the ribbon corresponding to the Plurispecialista OPSA qualification. It represents the award; obtaining and wearing it should follow the rules set by the Corpo Militare Croce Rossa and your unit.

Tip: Choose the finish and attachment that match your uniform or display needs, and check related ribbon bars and mounting accessories to complete a neat, regulation-compliant presentation.
