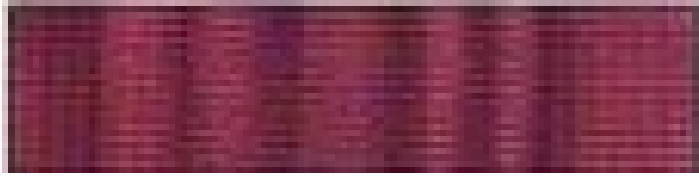

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: use the Nastrino Volontari Guerra 1915-18 on a single ribbon bar, part of a multi-ribbon display, or as a loose ribbon for restoration and craft projects. Choose the 37 mm for prominent display or 20 mm for compact ribbon racks.

In most cases, collectors and reenactors mount the ribbon on a metal ribbon holder using either the clamp or screw option; museums and displays often prefer the Elite slightly domed finish for a cleaner look. This ribbon is also suitable for military surplus displays and tactical or duty uniform restorations where historical accuracy is required.

Care and notes

Handle the ribbon gently and select the mounting style and size that match your display or uniform. Availability may be limited, and loose ribbon has a minimum order length.

- Store away from direct sunlight to preserve the crimson color.
- Order the correct width (37 mm or 20 mm) to match your ribbon bar.
- Specify clamp or screw attachment when ordering mounted ribbons.
- Loose ribbon minimum order: 50 cm.
- Limited availability due to historical demand—check stock before finalizing display plans.

Q: What does the Nastrino Volontari Guerra 1915-18 represent?

A: It is a crimson ribbon that recognizes volunteers who responded to the call to arms between 1915 and 1918 during World War I.

Q: Which sizes are available?



A: The ribbon is available in two widths: 37 mm and 20 mm, suitable for different ribbon bars and display preferences.

Q: What finish options are there?

A: You can choose the regular flat finish or the slightly domed "Elite" variant for a more refined appearance.

Q: What mounting options exist for the ribbon?

A: Mounted ribbons come with a portanastrino (ribbon holder) that can be fitted with either a clamp (morsetto) or screws; select your preference when ordering.

Q: Can I buy this ribbon as loose material?

A: Yes. Loose ribbon is available to order with a minimum length of 50 cm; ideal for restorations or custom displays.

Q: Can multiple ribbons be mounted together?

A: Yes. The Nastrino Volontari Guerra 1915-18 can be assembled on multi-ribbon holders designed to house two or more ribbons on a single metal base.

Tip: Choose the correct width (37 mm or 20 mm) and your preferred mounting (clamp or screws) before checkout, and browse related ribbon holders and display items to complete your historical or tactical/military surplus collection.
