Product overview

The Nastrino Corpo Spedizione Italiano in Russia is a historic military ribbon for collectors, reenactors, and museums. It was awarded to personnel of the CSIR (Corpo Spedizione Italiano in Russia) who served on the Eastern Front and is suited for display on ribbon bars or as part of military surplus collections.



Definition: a two-tone (white and black) 37 mm service ribbon representing the colors of Udine and the CSIR expedition. This military ribbon is also useful for tactical uniform reproductions and duty-display pieces.

Main features

Clear, durable construction with multiple finishing and mounting options to suit collectors and uniform restorers.

- **Historical design:** Bipartite white and black ribbon reflecting the colors of Udine, the expedition's departure city.
- **Standard size:** Supplied in the regulatory 37 mm width.
- **Durable materials:** Made from resilient fabric intended for long-term display and handling.
- **Finishing options:** Choose flat regulatory finish or the domed Elite variant.
- **Mounting choices:** Completed with a ribbon-bar holder fitted with either a clamp or screws, selectable from the product options.
- **Loose ribbon available:** Can be bought as a loose ribbon for custom mounting on multi-position ribbon bars.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: Use this ribbon on a single or multi-position ribbon bar for display, museum exhibits, or historically accurate uniform builds. Select the mounting and finish that match your display needs before adding to cart.

In most cases, collectors buy the finished ribbon with the preferred attachment (clamp or screws). Reenactors and restorers often choose the loose ribbon option to arrange multiple ribbons on one metal bar or to match period-correct presentation.

Care and notes

Carefully select the finish and attachment when ordering; keep the ribbon dry and handle gently to preserve color and shape.

- Store flat or on a proper ribbon bar to avoid creasing.
- Clean gently with a soft, dry cloth; avoid water and solvents.
- Check the selected attachment (clamp or screws) before checkout to ensure compatibility with your ribbon bar.
- Available in limited quantities; orders may be filled on a first-come basis.

FAQ

Q: What are the ribbon dimensions?



A: The ribbon is supplied in the regulatory 37 mm width. Length matches standard ribbon-bar sizing for display.

Q: Can I choose the type of attachment for the ribbon bar holder?

A: Yes. You can select either a clamp-style attachment or a screw-mounted attachment from the product options before adding to cart.

Q: Is the ribbon available as a loose strip?

A: Yes. There is an option to buy the ribbon as a loose strip if you prefer to mount it yourself on a custom or multi-position ribbon bar.

Q: What finishing options are offered?

A: Two finishing options are available: the flat regulatory finish and the domed Elite variant. Choose the finish that fits your display preference.

Q: Is this ribbon suitable for multi-position ribbon bars?

A: Yes. The ribbon is compatible with multi-position ribbon bars; select loose ribbon or the correct holder attachment for multi-ribbon assemblies.

Q: Why is this ribbon significant?

A: The ribbon was attributed to members of the CSIR who served on the Eastern Front and uses the white and black colors of Udine, linking it directly to that historical expedition.

Tip: Choose the correct finish and attachment for your intended display—flat or Elite, clamp or screws—and consider browsing related ribbon bars and mounting accessories to complete your setup.
