## Product overview

The Cappello Alpino Primo Luogotenente Alpini Paracadutisti is a premium Alpine hat designed for collectors, ceremonial use, and military memorabilia enthusiasts. It is aimed at buyers who

Definition: a rabbit-felt Alpine hat fitted with a gold canutiglia embroidered badge, an enamel paratrooper pulce, the Primo Luogotenente rank braid with two stars, a metal tassel and a flexible black pen with rimbecco. Available from Tutto Militare for military surplus, tactical and duty display purposes.

### Main features

High-end materials and complete fittings make this model suitable for display, representation and serious collecting.

- **Premium rabbit felt** for compact shape, smooth finish and longer perceived life.
- **Gold canutiglia badge** centrally embroidered for raised relief and shine.
- **Enamel pulce (parachute symbol on black)** mounted on the badge to indicate paratrooper specialization.
- **Primo Luogotenente rank** (gold/black braid on red cloth) with two silver stars mounted on the right side.
- **Metal tassel and flexible black pen with rimbecco** included for a finished, durable appearance.
- Ready-to-display configuration—no extra parts required for representational use.

### How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: ideal for collection, ceremonial wear, museum display and formal presentation where authentic appearance matters. Use it as a showpiece or for official-style events, not as certified operational gear.

In most cases, buyers choose this hat for visual accuracy and quality materials rather than field use. It suits collectors of military surplus, reenactors needing a tactical-looking cap for display, and anyone seeking a duty-style hat with complete insignia.

### Care and notes

Proper storage and gentle cleaning preserve the felt, embroidery and metal details.

- Keep in a dry place away from direct sunlight to avoid fading and moisture damage.
- Store on a rigid support or inside a hard case to maintain shape and protect the badge.
- Clean with a soft brush or dry cloth; avoid water and chemical cleaners that can harm felt and metalwork.
- Handle the canutiglia and pulce gently to prevent deformation of the embroidery and enamel.

### FAQ



**Q:** What is the difference between rabbit felt and wool felt for Alpine hats?

**A:** Rabbit felt is denser and smoother, giving better shape retention and a cleaner surface. Wool felt is still durable, but rabbit felt is preferred for higher-end display models.

**Q:** Is the central badge really embroidered in gold canutiglia?

**A:** Yes. The central badge is embroidered with gold canutiglia, a traditional metallic thread technique that produces raised relief and a brighter finish than standard embroidery.

**Q:** What is the enamel "pulce" and what does the parachute symbol signify?

**A:** The pulce is a small enamel metal pin fixed to the badge. The parachute symbol on a black field identifies the paratrooper specialization and completes the visual code of the hat.

**Q:** Is the Primo Luogotenente rank already mounted on the hat?

**A:** Yes. The hat is supplied with the Primo Luogotenente rank mounted on the right side: a gold-and-black gallone on red cloth with two silver stars at the end.

**Q:** Are the metal tassel and pen included, and what type of pen is it?

**A:** Both are included. The tassel is metal and gold-coloured, and the pen is a flexible black model with a rimbecco to reduce damage and keep a neat appearance.

**Q:** Is this hat suitable for collection and exhibition?

**A:** Yes. The premium materials, complete insignia and careful mounting make it well suited for collectors and display contexts such as cabinets, exhibitions or formal presentations.

**Tip:** Choose the correct variant or size for display and handling, and consider browsing matching accessories (replacement pens, nappine, badge options and a hard case) to complete your set.
