Product overview

The Acciarino Kit Accensione Fuoco is a compact firestarter kit for outdoor users, campers, hikers, and professionals who need a reliable ignition tool for emergency, tactical, or everyday duty use. It is designed to work without matches, gas, or batteries and fits a pocket, pouch, or emergency kit.



Definition: A magnesium/ferrocium firestarter kit that produces hot sparks to ignite prepared tinder quickly and reliably. Available from Tutto Militare for military surplus, tactical, and police equipment needs.

Main features

This kit focuses on durability, repeatable performance and easy transport. Key elements are built for field use and simple maintenance.

- **Magnesium/ferrocium bar:** the spark-producing core designed for many ignitions when used correctly.
- **Ignition aids (varies by configuration):** some kits include dry tinder or solid fuel to speed up first light.
- **Protective metal container:** shock and dirt protection with quick open/close access.
- **No external power:** works without gas, batteries or refills, suitable for long-term storage.
- **Compact and portable:** small footprint for backpacks, duty kits or survival pouches.

How to use / When it's useful

Prepare a safe, clear area, arrange dry tinder and small kindling, then scrape the rod firmly with a scraper or the back of a blade so sparks land on the tinder. Quick answer: use a decisive, controlled scraping motion aimed at the prepared tinder to get a reliable ignition.

In most cases, this kit outperforms matches or lighters in wind, cold, or damp conditions when paired with dry tinder. Practice the technique at home; it is ideal as a primary tool or a backup for tactical, camping, military surplus, or police use.

Care and notes

Keep the kit clean and dry and check components after use. Follow basic fire safety when operating the starter.

- Clean out metal container of dust and debris after use.
- Store the kit dry; consider a small desiccant pack in your pouch.
- Use the scraper provided or a safe, suitable tool; avoid risky blade techniques.
- Never leave a fire unattended and choose a safe, cleared ignition area.

FAQ

Q: Does the firestarter work in wind and humidity?

A: Yes. Sparks from the rod are effective in windy or damp conditions when directed onto a well-prepared, dry tinder. Wind protection and good tinder improve success.



Q: How many ignitions can I expect from the bar?

A: The rod is built for multiple ignitions. Actual counts depend on scraping intensity and frequency of use; careful technique extends lifespan.

Q: Do I need a dedicated scraper?

A: A proper scraper makes ignition easier and safer. Use the tool supplied by the kit or a suitable, controlled implement rather than improvising unsafe methods.

Q: Is this kit suitable for camping and hiking?

A: Yes. Its compact size and independence from fuel or batteries make it a reliable choice for camping, hiking, and tactical or duty kits.

Q: Can it be my only fire source?

A: It can serve as a primary method, but carrying a backup (for example, a lighter) and sufficient dry tinder is recommended for maximum reliability.

Q: How should I store and maintain the kit?

A: Keep the kit dry, clean residual powder from the case, and store in a sealed pouch or container with a desiccant if possible to protect components over time.

Tip: Choose the right kit variant and size for your needs and pair the firestarter with dry tinder, a pouch, paracord and a tactical torch for the most reliable field setup. Browse related tactical and military surplus items to round out your emergency or duty kit.
