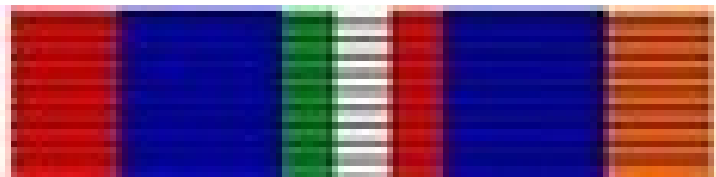

Product overview

The Nastrino Ottava Nona Decima Armata is a historic service ribbon associated with the Ottava, Nona and Decima Armata that served in World War I. It is intended for collectors, museums, reenactors and anyone preserving Italian military heritage.

Definition: a fabric service ribbon in blue with red and orange edges and a central tricolour stripe, produced for display and uniform reproduction. This ribbon is offered in limited quantities and is



packaged to maintain consistent quality.

Main features

Durable, historically styled ribbon available in two finishes and multiple mounting options for display or uniform use.

- **High-quality materials:** woven fabric for long-lasting color and shape.
- **Distinctive colors:** blue field, red and orange edge stripes, central tricolour band.
- **Two finishes:** regular flat format and slightly curved Elite variant.
- **Mounting options:** available fitted to a ribbon mount with clamp or with screws selectable from the product menu.
- **Multi-ribbon compatibility:** can be mounted on multi-ribbon bars to display several ribbons together.
- **Suitable for:** military ribbon collections, military surplus retail, tactical and ceremonial displays.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: use this nastrino for uniform reproduction, museum exhibits, collector displays, or reenactment uniforms. Choose the flat or Elite finish to match the original look you want to reproduce.

In most cases, select the mounting style (clamp or screws) that fits your ribbon bar or display base. The ribbon can be combined with other ribbons on a single metal mount and is suitable for duty or ceremonial presentation when accurate appearance is required.

Care and notes

Keep the ribbon clean and protected to preserve colors and fabric structure; packaging is done to maintain quality during storage and shipping.

- Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight to prevent fading.
- Do not machine wash; spot clean gently if necessary.
- When mounting, secure clamps or screws firmly to prevent loss.
- Availability is limited—stock may run low due to demand.

FAQ

Q: What formats are available?

A: The ribbon is offered in the regular flat format and a slightly curved Elite variant. Both finishes are produced to match common historical presentations.



Q: Can I choose how the ribbon is mounted?

A: Yes. You can select a ribbon mount with a clamp or with screws from the product options on the page to suit your display or uniform bar.

Q: Can this ribbon be mounted with others on one base?

A: Yes. The nastrino can be fitted to multi-ribbon mounts that hold several ribbons side by side on a single metal base for an orderly display.

Q: What are the ribbon colors and their layout?

A: The ribbon has a blue field, red and orange edge stripes at the ends, and a central tricolour stripe. The pattern matches the historic design described for the Ottava Nona Decima Armata.

Q: How can I be sure of product quality?

A: Each ribbon is made from durable woven fabric and packaged carefully to ensure consistent finish and shipment condition. Inspect on receipt and follow care notes to maintain appearance.

Q: Is this ribbon an original World War I issue?

A: The ribbon pattern is historically associated with members of the Ottava, Nona and Decima Armata who served in World War I. This product is a produced service ribbon offered for display and collection purposes.

Tip: Choose the finish and mounting option that match your intended use (flat or Elite; clamp or screws) and check related ribbons and ribbon mounts to complete a consistent display. Availability may be limited, so select your variant while stock remains.
