Main features

- **Natural cooling trick:** Wetting the liner before use can help enhance the fresh, cool feel of the liquid inside.
- **Compact size:** Measures 12.5 x 21.5 x 7.5 cm, easy to carry during daily use or outdoor missions.
- **Suitable for hot or cold drinks:** The liner helps maintain beverage temperature for extended periods.

How to use / When it's useful

Use the canteen as your primary water container during patrols, hikes, training, or travel. Insert water purification tablets into the lined pocket according to the tablet instructions when source water quality is uncertain.

Quick answer: It's ideal for tactical and outdoor situations where durability and simple water treatment matter. In most cases, mount it to your belt or pack using the ALICE clips for hands-free carry and fast access.

Care and notes

Simple care keeps the canteen safe and functional. Follow basic cleaning and tablet instructions and inspect the liner and clips before each use.

- Wash before first use and rinse after each use with warm, soapy water.



- Avoid abrasive cleaners that could damage the liner; hand wash recommended.
- Follow purification tablet manufacturer directions; do not add tablets directly to concentrated chemicals.
- Check the liner and clips regularly for cracks or damage; replace if compromised.

FAQ

Q: Can I use this canteen for hot drinks?

A: Yes. The thermal liner helps retain heat, so it can be used for warm beverages. Allow cooling time before drinking and handle carefully to avoid burns.

Q: How do I use water purification tablets with this canteen?

A: Place tablets in the integrated pocket or follow the tablet maker's instructions. Ensure contact time as specified before drinking to ensure effective purification.

Q: Is the canteen resistant to shocks and drops?

A: The shockproof thermal liner provides added protection against impacts, reducing the risk of damage during normal outdoor use. Inspect after any heavy impact.

Q: Can I attach the canteen to my belt or pack?

A: Yes. The rear ALICE-style clips are designed for easy attachment to belts, webbing and most backpacks for secure, accessible carry.

Q: What are the canteen dimensions and capacity?

A: The canteen holds 1 liter and measures 12.5 x 21.5 x 7.5 cm, making it compact enough for daily carry and field operations.

Q: Is the liner made from food-safe materials and how do I clean it?

A: The liner is made from food-grade plastic. Clean with warm soapy water, rinse thoroughly, and air-dry. Avoid harsh solvents or abrasive pads.
