Product overview

The Sciabola Sottufficiali Guardia di Finanza Scuola Marescialli is a ceremonial sabre made for non-commissioned officers and students of the Guardia di Finanza Scuola Allievi Marescialli. It is



intended for official ceremonial use and for verified collectors connected to the Corps.

Definition: a ceremonial sabre that reproduces the Subofficer infantry pattern and bears the Corps' heraldic emblem. This piece combines traditional design with durable materials for duty and display in military, tactical, or military surplus collections.

Main features

Key details and visible elements that define this sabre:

- **Authentic design:** Shape matches the Subofficers' infantry sabre pattern with a straight blade engraved with the Corps crest.
- **Steel guard:** The metal guard is split into two largely symmetrical branches for strength and period appearance.
- **Ergonomic grip:** Handle has four internal grooves to fit the fingers for a secure hold.
- **Distinctive scabbard detail:** The Guardia di Finanza flame is reproduced on the metal scabbard.
- **Reserved sale:** Purchase is limited to personnel of the Scuola Allievi Marescialli or members of the Guardia di Finanza; collectors may buy under license conditions.

How to use / When it's useful

Use this sabre primarily for formal ceremonies, parades, honor guards, and as a display item in official uniforms or curated military surplus collections. It is a symbolic object representing service, tradition, and duty.

Quick answer: It is intended for Guardia di Finanza personnel and licensed collectors for ceremonial or display use. In most cases, buyers must provide verification documents before the sale is completed.

Care and notes

Basic care preserves the finish and the emblem detail; follow service rules for storage and transport.

- Keep the blade and metal parts dry and lightly oiled to prevent corrosion.
- Store in a suitable scabbard or padded case to protect the blade and scabbard ornament.
- Sale is reserved to Scuola Allievi Marescialli personnel or Guardia di Finanza members; collectors must provide the prefectural license (art. 28 TULPS).
- To complete the order, send by email your Command station and the purchaser's codice fiscale as verification.
- Delivery is estimated at about 20 working days from payment.

FAQ



Q: Who can purchase this sabre?

A: Sale is reserved to members of the Scuola Allievi Marescialli or to serving personnel of the Guardia di Finanza. Collectors may purchase only with the required license.

Q: What documents do I need to provide to buy?

A: You must email the Command station where you serve and the purchaser's codice fiscale. Collectors must also send a copy of the prefectural license under art. 28 TULPS.

Q: How long does delivery take?

A: Delivery is expected in approximately 20 working days from the date of payment, subject to verification of required documents.

Q: What materials are used in the sabre?

A: The sabre features a straight blade with the Corps crest, a steel guard split into two branches, and an ergonomic grip with four finger grooves. No additional technical specifications are claimed.

Q: Can collectors buy this item?

A: Yes, collectors can purchase the sabre only after submitting the prefectural license (art. 28 TULPS) as required by law and after seller verification.

Q: Is this sabre intended for combat or everyday use?

A: This is a ceremonial sabre intended for formal duty, parade, and display. Follow your unit's rules for handling, transport, and use.
