Product overview

The Fregio Basco Ricamoto Cavalleria Fuori Corpo is an embroidered beret badge for collectors, re-enactors, uniform enthusiasts, and duty or police-style apparel. Definition: it is a gold canutiglia (bullion) embroidered cavalry badge mounted on black cloth, designed for display on a beret.

Made with detailed bullion stitching, the badge shows a grenade resting on a trumpet, a straight seven-tongued flame and two crossed lances. It measures 6.5 x 5 cm and is offered in limited quantities, making it a sought-after piece for military surplus and tactical-style collections.

Main features

Clear, durable embroidery and a classic cavalry motif make this badge suitable for berets and display pieces.

- **Material:** Gold canutiglia (bullion) embroidery on black cloth.
- **Design:** Grenade over a trumpet, straight flame with seven tongues, and two crossed lances.
- **Size:** 6.5 x 5 cm — compact and proportional for most berets.
- **Application:** Can be sewn on or attached by a tailor; made for easy installation.
- **Finish:** High-detail embroidery for crisp, visible motifs.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: attach the badge to your beret by hand-sewing or machine-sewing, or have it fitted by a uniform tailor. It is designed to sit flat and be visible without being bulky.

In most cases, the badge works well for collectors, re-enactors, and anyone adding cavalry-style detail to tactical, military surplus, or police-duty apparel. Use it for ceremonial pieces, display mounts, or to personalize a service-style beret.

Care and notes

Keep the embroidery and bullion threads in good condition with gentle care.

- Spot clean with a mild detergent; avoid abrasive scrubbing.
- Sew-on attachment is more durable than simple adhesives; secure stitching is recommended.
- Avoid direct heat or ironing on the bullion areas to prevent damage.
- Check unit or organizational regulations before adding to an official uniform.



FAQ

Q: What are the exact dimensions of the badge?

A: The badge measures 6.5 x 5 cm. It is sized to fit most standard berets without appearing oversized.

Q: What materials are used in the embroidery?

A: The badge is embroidered in gold canutiglia (bullion) on black cloth for a traditional cavalry look and clear contrast.

Q: How do I attach the badge to my beret?

A: You can sew the badge on by hand or machine. For a cleaner or official fit, consider having it attached by a uniform tailor.

Q: Will this badge fit any beret?

A: Yes, it is designed to adapt to most beret types. Check placement and orientation before permanently sewing to ensure the best fit.

Q: Are other sizes or colors available?

A: Currently this badge is available only in the specified size and gold-on-black colorway as described.

Q: Is this an official military insignia?

A: The badge reflects cavalry symbolism and tradition. For use on official uniforms, confirm with your unit or organization's regulations before applying.
