## Product short description:

Scudetto Ricamato Frece Tricolori is an embroidered patch for aviation fans and collectors, inspired by the Italian aerobatic team and its tricolour.

- **Material:** Durable materials to resist wear and keep appearance.
- **Design:** Detailed embroidery in green, white and red to evoke the Tricolore.
- **Use:** Suitable for jackets, backpacks, rucksacks or display in a personal collection.

## Product description:

### Product overview

The Scudetto Ricamato Frece Tricolori is an embroidered iron-on patch that reproduces the emblem of the Pattuglia Acrobatica Nazionale (P.A.N.) of the Aeronautica Militare Italiana. It is designed for aviation fans, military surplus collectors, pilots, and anyone who wants to customize flight suits, jackets, bombers or tactical gear.

Definition: a high-quality embroidered patch (7.7 cm x 9.8 cm) representing the three MB-339 tricolour arrows on a dark blue background. Use cases include pilot apparel, tactical patches,



military surplus collections and everyday duty or casual wear.

### Main features

Clear, durable construction with a practical iron-on backing makes this patch both decorative and functional.

- **Official licensed emblem** of the Frecce Tricolori (P.A.N.), reproduced with accurate colours and layout.
- **Size:** 7.7 cm x 9.8 cm — visible without being bulky.
- **Material:** durable fabric base and high-quality embroidery for long-lasting colour.
- **Backing:** thermoadhesive (iron-on) for quick application to heat-resistant textiles.
- **Design:** three MB-339 arrows in white, red and green on a dark blue field.

### How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: position the patch on a clean, dry, heat-resistant area, cover with a cloth and press with an iron for about 30 seconds, then let it cool; for best long-term hold, stitch the edges after ironing. This method works well on flight suits, pilot jackets, bombers, backpacks and other sturdy fabrics.

In most cases, the patch is ideal for tactical, military surplus and pilot clothing where a durable emblem is desired. Avoid ironing directly on delicate or heat-sensitive materials (see care notes), and consider sewing on gear that sees heavy use or frequent washing.

### Care and notes

Follow simple care steps to keep the patch looking sharp and to prolong attachment life.

- **Iron application:** use medium-high heat, cover the patch with a cloth and press for ~30 seconds; allow to cool before handling.
- **Sew edges** after applying for extra stability, especially on frequently washed items.
- **Machine wash** at moderate temperatures to preserve colours; avoid harsh detergents and long hot cycles.
- **Avoid prolonged direct sunlight** where possible to reduce gradual fading over many years.

### FAQ

**Q:** How do I apply the Scudetto Ricamato Frecce Tricolori?

**A:** Clean and dry the fabric, position the patch, cover with a thin cloth and press with an iron for about 30 seconds. Let it cool and, for best results, sew the edges to secure it long-term.

**Q:** Which garments can I apply it to?



**A:** It works well on flight suits, pilot jackets, bombers, backpacks and other heat-resistant textiles. Avoid delicate fabrics that may be damaged by ironing.

**Q:** Is this an official product?

**A:** Yes. The patch reproduces the official Frece Tricolori emblem and is offered with commercial licensing, ensuring authenticity and quality.

**Q:** What are the patch dimensions?

**A:** The patch measures 7.7 cm x 9.8 cm, sized to be clearly visible without overwhelming most clothing or gear.

**Q:** Will it survive washing?

**A:** The materials are designed to withstand regular wear and washing if you follow care advice: use moderate temperatures and consider stitching the edges for greater durability.

**Q:** Can I sew it on instead of ironing?

**A:** Yes. Sewing only is a reliable option, especially for fabrics that cannot tolerate heat or for items that undergo heavy use.

**Tip:** Choose the right placement and consider stitching the edges after ironing for maximum durability; check related aviation and tactical patches to complete your gear.
