## Product overview

The Fregio Ufficiali Alpini Paracadutisti is an embroidered badge for officers of the Corpo degli Alpini who hold the parachutist qualification; it is designed to be worn on the alpine hat by qualified officers. Definition: a metal-thread embroidered insignia in grey/green cloth that identifies Alpini parachutist officers.



This badge combines symbols of the Esercito Italiano and the Truppe Alpine and is produced in limited quantities. It is suitable for military surplus collectors, tactical gear displays, and officers who need an authentic duty insignia.

### Main features

Clear, durable construction and a recognisable design make this badge both a service emblem and a collector's piece.

- **Distinctive design:** Eagle in flight clutching an open parachute with cords converging on a winged dagger.
- **High-quality embroidery:** Metal thread in gold or silver on grey/green cloth for a traditional look.
- **Official meaning:** Signifies the union of Esercito Italiano and Truppe Alpine roles and the wearer's parachutist qualification.
- **For alpine hats:** Sized and made for standard alpini officer headgear.
- **Limited availability:** Produced in small runs, sought after by collectors and service personnel.

### How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: wear the badge on the alpine officer hat to show parachutist qualification or add it to a military surplus collection for display. It is intended for officers who have completed the required parachute training.

In most cases, the badge is issued after successfully finishing the military parachuting course (about two weeks of training). It is useful on duty for identification and in ceremonial contexts, and also appeals to collectors of tactical and duty insignia.

### Care and notes

Basic care preserves the metal thread and cloth—handle gently and store away from moisture and abrasion.

- Avoid machine washing; spot clean gently with a soft cloth and mild detergent if needed.
- Store flat or in a padded case to protect the embroidery and metal thread.
- Primarily intended for qualified officers; availability is limited and items may sell out.

### FAQ

**Q:** Who can wear the Fregio Ufficiali Alpini Paracadutisti?

**A:** The badge is reserved for officers of the Corpo degli Alpini who have earned the parachutist qualification. It represents an official service insignia.



**Q:** What materials are used?

**A:** The badge is embroidered with metal thread in gold or silver on grey?green cloth. The materials are chosen for traditional appearance and durability.

**Q:** What does the design represent?

**A:** The eagle symbolizes the Esercito Italiano; the parachute represents the Truppe Alpine. Together they signify strength, skill, and alpine parachute service.

**Q:** How is the badge obtained?

**A:** Officers receive the badge after passing a military parachute course. The course typically lasts about two weeks and includes ground and airborne training.

**Q:** Is the badge available for public purchase?

**A:** The badge is produced in limited quantities and is primarily intended for qualified officers. Availability to the general public may be restricted depending on stock and regulations.

**Q:** Where is the badge worn?

**A:** The embroidered fregio is designed to be worn on the alpine officer hat. It can also be displayed in collections of military surplus, tactical, or duty insignia.

**Tip:** Choose the correct thread color (gold or silver) and check compatibility with your alpine hat before purchasing; also browse related military surplus and tactical insignia to complete your display or uniform set.
