Product overview

The Basco Spagnolo Amaranto Mod. Paracadutisti is a maroon Spanish-style paratrooper beret designed for military personnel, police units, collectors and anyone seeking an authentic ceremonial or duty headpiece. Definition: this model is a maroon beret made from 100% high-



quality wool, built for durability and formal appearance.

Worn historically by elite units such as the 9° Col Moschin, Brigata Folgore, Savoia Cavalleria, GIS and NOCS, the beret combines tradition and a distinctive bordeaux color that signals prestige and unit identity. It fits both ceremonial and tactical-style contexts in military surplus, police and duty use.

Main features

Key features focus on material quality, classic construction and practical details that support badge attachment and comfort.

- **Material:** 100% high-quality wool for a formal look and long-term durability.
- **Gros-grain edge:** Stiff edge band preserves the beret shape and resists deformation.
- **Left-side reinforcement:** Reinforced parietal area designed to hold a paratrooper or Carabinieri Tuscania badge securely.
- **Plate diameter:** 22 cm plate for a bold, traditional profile when worn.
- **Breathable lining:** Internal mesh lining for ventilation and added comfort.
- **Ventilation:** Two lateral eyelets reduce heat and sweat during long wear.
- **Adjustable fit:** Rear strap allows quick size adjustment for a stable fit.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: wear it as a ceremonial or duty beret—centered on the head with the badge on the left parietal side and adjusted with the rear strap for a secure fit. In most cases, it is used for parades, official ceremonies, commemorative events, or as part of a military or police uniform ensemble.

The beret also works well for collectors and reenactors who value authentic styling and military surplus items. For tactical or duty contexts, ensure proper placement and secure the badge using the reinforced area so the insignia remains visible and stable.

Care and notes

Basic care preserves the wool and shape of the beret while keeping the reinforcement and lining in good condition.

- Prefer professional dry cleaning or gentle hand wash in cold water; avoid harsh machine cycles.
- Reshape while damp and dry flat away from direct heat to maintain the plate and gros-grain edge.
- Do not use bleach or strong detergents; avoid prolonged exposure to heavy rain to protect wool fibers.
- Store flat or on a hat block to preserve shape and protect the reinforcement area for any



badge.

FAQ

Q: What material is the beret made of?

A: The Basco Spagnolo Amaranto Mod. Paracadutisti is made from 100% high-quality wool, chosen for its appearance and durability in formal and duty settings.

Q: How do I choose the correct size?

A: Measure head circumference with a flexible tape across the forehead and above the ears. Use that measurement to select the appropriate size; the rear strap allows fine adjustment for a snug fit.

Q: Can I attach a badge to this beret?

A: Yes. The beret includes a reinforcement on the left parietal side specifically designed to hold paratrooper or Carabinieri Tuscania insignia securely and visibly.

Q: Is the beret available in other colors?

A: This model is offered in amaranto (bordeaux/maroon), the traditional color associated with paratrooper units. Check available listings for any additional color variants.

Q: Is this beret suitable for active field use?

A: The beret is designed for ceremonial and duty wear with durable materials, breathability and adjustability. For intensive field operations, follow your unit's equipment guidance.

Q: How should I clean and store the beret?

A: Prefer professional dry cleaning or gentle hand washing, reshape while damp and dry flat. Store flat or on a hat form to keep the plate and edge in shape.

Tip: Choose the correct size before ordering and consider related military surplus and tactical headgear to complete a ceremonial or duty kit. Browse similar berets and insignia options to match your unit or collection preferences.
