## Product short description:

Bersaglieri beret with Fregio Storico and Piumetto — a timeless piece of Italian military tradition for collectors and enthusiasts. Made from quality materials, it features authentic historic detailing and is suitable to wear with pride or display as part of a collection.

- **Material:** Made from quality materials true to traditional beret style.
- **Badge:** Fregio Storico (historic badge) affixed to the beret.
- **Plume:** Characteristic piumetto (feather plume) for distinctive appearance.

## Product overview

The Basco Bersaglieri with historic badge and black plume is a traditional-style wool beret aimed at collectors, reenactors, ceremonial users, and buyers of military surplus, tactical or duty/police



accessories. It reproduces the classic Bersaglieri headgear with authentic visual details for display or uniform use.

Definition: a 100% wool Bersaglieri beret fitted with a historic metal badge set on crimson cloth and a removable black piumetto (plume).

### Main features

Solid construction and period details made for authenticity, comfort and collectible value.

- **100% wool:** warm, breathable and durable material.
- **Gros-grain border 2 cm:** neat finish around the rim.
- **Cremisi square 8 x 8 cm:** crimson cloth backing for the badge.
- **Historic Bersaglieri badge:** set in a metal ring 4 mm thick and 5.6 cm diameter, centered on the underpanel.
- **Black plume with metal mount:** removable piumetto supplied with a metal support for attachment to the badge.
- **Plate diameter 22 cm:** standard beret size for a comfortable fit.
- **Blue tails (gale):** the terminal tails shown as part of the original styling.

### How to use / When it's useful

Use this beret for ceremonial wear, uniform displays, historical reenactment or as a collector's item from military surplus and tactical gear. Quick answer: suitable for display or light duty/uniform use, not heavy field wear.

For styling, position the beret with the badge centered and the plate at about 22 cm across the head; the plume can be attached for formal occasions and removed for storage. In most cases, follow the size guide to choose the correct fit and remove the piumetto before dry cleaning or compact storage.

### Care and notes

Simple care keeps the beret in shape and preserves its historic details.

- Dry clean only to protect the wool and badge.
- Store flat or on a hat form to maintain shape; avoid prolonged moisture.
- Remove the plume before cleaning or packing; the piumetto uses a metal support for attachment.
- Note: the model was discontinued without the plume on 1 November 2015; availability is limited.

### FAQ



**Q:** What are the beret dimensions?

**A:** The beret has a plate (piatto) diameter of 22 cm. The crimson backing for the badge is an 8 x 8 cm square, and the badge sits in a metal ring 5.6 cm in diameter and 4 mm thick.

**Q:** Is the piumetto (plume) removable?

**A:** Yes. The black piumetto is supplied with a metal support for attachment to the badge and can be removed when needed.

**Q:** Are multiple sizes available?

**A:** Yes, the beret is offered in different sizes. Check the size guide on the product page to select the correct fit for head measurements.

**Q:** Is this beret suitable for all seasons?

**A:** The beret is 100% wool, so it provides warmth in cooler weather while remaining reasonably comfortable in milder seasons.

**Q:** How should I clean the beret?

**A:** Professional dry cleaning is recommended to preserve the wool, the badge, and the plume support. Remove the piumetto before cleaning.

**Q:** Is this the same model used by the Bersaglieri today?

**A:** This product features the historic Bersaglieri badge and traditional styling. Note that the specific model was discontinued without the plume on 1 November 2015, so versions and availability may vary.

**Tip:** Choose the correct size using the size guide and consider whether you want the model with or without the piumetto; browse related berets and uniform accessories to complete a period-accurate look without overspending.
