Product overview

Golden Mantle Fasteners (Mascheroni Dorati per Mantella) are decorative metal fasteners for ceremonial cloaks and uniform mantles, suitable for ceremonial duty, formal uniforms and restoration work. They add a refined, historic look while serving as functional cloak closures.

Definition: a mascherone is a gold-finished metal cloak fastener with a raised lion head motif and a hook-and-chain set. These pieces are gold-plated metal, finely finished and produced in limited



quantities.

Main features

Well-finished gold-plated metal fasteners with a distinctive relief design and balanced dimensions for an elegant, proportional look.

- Material: gold-plated metal with a warm, glossy finish designed for durability.
- Center design: raised lion head motif symbolizing strength and formality.
- Functional elements: right-side hook and left-side chain made of eight circular links.
- Placement guidance: sewn about 9 cm below the collar and about 8.5 cm from the mantle edges.
- Size: diameter approximately 34 mm for a balanced visual proportion.
- Hand-finished production and limited availability due to artisanal work.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: sew each fastener into the mantle fabric where the collar meets the body, keeping the recommended spacing (about 9 cm below the collar and 8.5 cm from the edge) to keep the look balanced. The hook should sit on the right side and the chain on the left.

In most cases, these fasteners are used on ceremonial cloaks, uniform mantles and restoration projects where traditional appearance matters. They are decorative and functional, adding formality without overpowering the overall garment design.

Care and notes

Basic care preserves finish and function—handle gently and avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaning.

- Wipe with a soft, dry or slightly damp cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners.
- Sew in place with precision to maintain correct spacing and balance; consider a professional tailor for delicate fabrics.
- Store in a dry place to reduce risk of tarnish or wear over time.
- Plating is designed for durability but may show signs of wear with heavy use; treat as a decorative accessory.

FAQ

Q: What is the diameter of the mascheroni?

A: Each mascherone has a diameter of approximately 34 mm. This size keeps the fastener visually balanced on most mantles.



Q: What material are they made from?

A: They are made from gold-plated metal, offering the appearance of gold with a durable finish designed for decorative and functional use.

Q: How are the mascheroni attached to the mantle?

A: They are sewn in place. Recommended placement is about 9 cm below the collar and about 8.5 cm from the mantle edges to ensure correct alignment and visibility.

Q: What is the design detail in the center?

A: Each fastener features a raised lion head in the center, a traditional symbol that adds a formal, ceremonial character to the mantle.

Q: Is the gold finish durable?

A: The gold plating is applied for resistance and durability, but like all plated finishes it can show wear over long periods of heavy use. Gentle care is recommended.

Q: Can these be used on other garments besides mantles?

A: Yes. They can be adapted to other ceremonial garments or restoration projects where a similar size and style suit the design, provided the fabric can support sewing and the weight of the metal.

Tip: Choose the correct placement and confirm the number of fasteners needed for your mantle before checkout, and consider browsing related ceremonial hardware and sewing accessories to complete the look.
