The Scarponi Antitaglio Latemar KL3 GTX by Crispi are heavy-duty safety boots designed for professionals who work outdoors in mountainous, forested or otherwise harsh environments. They combine cut resistance, waterproofing and impact protection for forestry workers, rescue teams, tactical and duty users.

Definition: the Latemar KL3 GTX is a Class 3 cut-resistant, waterproof safety boot built for demanding outdoor and professional use.

Main features

Key protective and performance features designed for safety, comfort and traction:

- **Class 3 cut resistance**—certified cut protection for higher-risk tasks.
- **Robust anti-crush toe cap** that protects against impact and compression.
- **360° rubber rand (fascione)** for added abrasion and impact protection around the foot.
- **Anti-perforation midsole** to guard against sharp objects underfoot.
- **Crosta Nepal hydro upper** for water resistance and long-term durability.
- **Gore-Tex membrane** for waterproofing with breathability.
- **Vibram® crampon-capable outsole** with a cushioned PU midsole for traction and reduced fatigue.
- **Removable Cambrelle® insole** and a differentiated footbed for comfort during long shifts.

How to use / When it's useful

These boots are intended for professionals working in forestry, mountain rescue, outdoor maintenance, tactical and duty roles where cut, puncture and impact risks are present. They perform well on rough terrain and in wet conditions, providing a balance of protection and comfort.

Quick answer: Use the Latemar KL3 GTX whenever you need certified cut resistance, waterproofing and reliable traction. In most cases, pair them with performance socks and the correct size to get the best fit and insulation for cold-weather deployments.

Care and notes

Basic care extends the life and performance of these boots—clean off mud, dry at room temperature and treat the leather with appropriate products for water-resistant uppers.

- Clean off dirt and debris after use; let boots air dry naturally away from direct heat.
- Use leather care products suitable for Crosta Nepal hydro to maintain water resistance.
- Remove and air the Cambrelle® insole regularly; replace if worn to keep support.
- Limited stock: availability can be low due to demand—confirm size and order promptly.
- Note: cut-resistant does not mean cut-proof—follow safe operating practices when handling sharp tools.



FAQ

Q: Are the Latemar KL3 GTX boots waterproof?

A: Yes. They use a Gore-Tex membrane that provides waterproof protection while allowing breathability to help keep feet dry.

Q: What does the Class 3 cut resistance mean?

A: Class 3 indicates a high level of cut resistance as supplied by the manufacturer's certification. It is suitable for tasks with an elevated risk of blade contact.

Q: Can I use these boots in very cold weather?

A: The Gore-Tex membrane and construction offer protection and some insulation, but performance in extreme cold depends on socks and layering; they are not specialized insulated winter boots.

Q: Are the soles suitable for steep or icy terrain?

A: The Vibram® crampon-capable outsole provides strong traction on mixed terrain. For ice-specific conditions, consider adding compatible crampons or traction devices.

Q: Are these boots comfortable for long shifts?

A: Yes. The PU cushioned midsole, differentiated footbed and removable Cambrelle® insole are designed to reduce fatigue and improve comfort during extended wear.

Q: How should I choose the right size and fit?

A: Try on boots with the socks you plan to wear on duty. Ensure toe room while the heel is secure. If unsure, consult size guidance from the retailer or order both sizes if stock is limited.

Tip: Choose the correct size and variant for your typical use and browse related tactical, duty and military surplus footwear to compare fit and features before purchasing.
