How to use / When it's useful

In most cases, these boots are best for professional forestry crews, arborists and technicians who need certified cut resistance, a secure fit, and breathable waterproofing during long shifts. Choose them when you need protection but also mobility for tactical-style or work activities.

Care and notes

Basic care extends the life and performance of the boots; follow standard leather and GORE-TEX maintenance practices.

- Wipe off mud and dry naturally after use; avoid direct heat sources.
- Use suitable leather cleaners and conditioners for the Crosta Nepal upper; follow GORE-TEX care instructions to preserve breathability.
- Remove and air the P 100 + Cambrelle® insole regularly to maintain hygiene and drying.
- Check the certification label periodically and replace boots or insoles if protective elements are worn.



- Warning: Do not assume protection beyond the Level 2 certification; use appropriate PPE for higher-risk operations.

Q: What level of cut protection do these boots provide?

A: The Crispi Forst KL2 GTX boots are certified for Level 2 cut protection, designed for common forestry cutting tasks. Always follow the certification limits and safe work procedures.

Q: Are these boots waterproof?

A: Yes. The boots include a GORE-TEX Performance Comfort membrane, providing waterproofing and breathability to keep feet dry in wet conditions.

Q: How much do the boots weigh?

A: Each boot weighs about 930 grams, offering a lightweight option that helps reduce fatigue during climbing and long days on the job.

Q: Is the insole removable?

A: Yes. The P 100 + Cambrelle® insole is removable for cleaning, replacement, or to accommodate custom orthotics.

Q: Are these boots suitable for tree climbing or free climbing?

A: They are suitable for tree climbing and free climbing activities thanks to their medium/soft flexibility and light weight, while providing certified cut protection.

Q: How do I choose the right size and fit?

A: Follow standard sizing guidance and consider the Instant Fit system, which provides a precise fit from the first wear. If you use thick socks or orthotics, try a size that accommodates them comfortably.
