The Black Flexible Eagle Quill for the Alpine Hat is a traditional decorative feather made for Alpini hats and for collectors, reenactors, and military surplus buyers. It is offered by Tutto Militare for customers who want an authentic-looking accessory that reflects Italian alpine military tradition.

Definition: a black flexible eagle quill is a feather ornament designed to be worn angled on the brim of an Alpine (Alpini) hat as a symbol of unit identity and patriotism. The quill carries historical and cultural meaning tied to the Alpini corps and the Verdi character Ernani.

### Main features

Key features at a glance:

- **Material:** selected eagle wing feathers, carefully chosen for appearance and flexibility.
- **Dimensions:** approximately 26 cm long, 5 cm wide, with a 4 cm quill (calamus).
- **Color:** black, the traditional shade used by the Alpini.
- **Fit:** designed to be mounted on Alpine/Alpini hats; suitable for display, ceremonial use, and collections.
- **Symbolism:** represents patriotism and the Alpine tradition linked to historic and cultural references.

### How to use / When it's useful

Attach the quill to the hat band or holder and place it slightly inclined on the left side of the alpine hat, as is customary for Alpini headgear. The feather is decorative and intended for ceremonial wear, historical reenactment, or display on a collector's hat.

Quick answer: wear the quill angled on the left brim of the Alpine hat for the traditional look. In most cases, this item is used for ceremonies, parades, uniforms for historical groups, and military surplus collections rather than everyday tactical duty.

### Care and notes

Store and handle the quill gently to preserve shape and color; avoid heavy moisture and excessive heat. Check local rules regarding feather possession, as some species are protected in certain countries.

- Keep dry and store flat or upright in a clean container to avoid bending.
- Handle by the quill base to prevent damage to the vane.
- Avoid prolonged exposure to sunlight or heat that can dry and weaken the feather.
- Verify local wildlife and import regulations before purchase; restrictions may apply to certain feathers.
- Limited stock may be available—purchase promptly if you need a specific item.

**Q:** What material is the quill made from?

**A:** The quill is made from selected eagle wing feathers as described. Selection focuses on flexibility and uniform appearance.

**Q:** What are the exact dimensions?

**A:** Approximately 26 cm in length, 5 cm in width, with a 4 cm calamus (quill base).

**Q:** How do I order the quill?

**A:** The black eagle quill is a long-standing symbol of the Alpini, linked to patriotism and resistance; its placement recalls the figure of Ernani from Verdi's opera.

**Q:** Are there any legal or care considerations?

**A:** Yes. Feathers from certain bird species can be subject to protection laws. Check local regulations and follow the care notes to preserve the item.
