Product overview

The Scudetto Ricamato Battaglione Alpini Tolmezzo is an embroidered shoulder patch for Alpini personnel, collectors, and anyone outfitting tactical, military surplus, or duty uniforms. Definition: an embroidered arm patch representing the Battaglione Alpini Tolmezzo, made to be sewn onto uniforms.

This low-visibility patch measures 6.5 x 9 cm and shows the Alpino's hand gripping a mountain rock — a symbol of strength and tradition. It is suitable for tactical and police use as well as for display on field jackets and uniform sleeves.

Main features

Clear, durable design made for uniform use and low-visibility applications.

- **Unique design:** Alpino hand gripping rock motif, symbolizing determination.
- **High-quality embroidery:** Precise stitching for a professional look and long life.
- **Size:** 6.5 x 9 cm, ideal for upper-arm or shoulder placement without being bulky.
- **Sew-on type:** No velcro included; intended to be sewn onto the uniform.
- **Low visibility:** Color and finish blend with camouflage for a discreet, duty-ready appearance.
- **Suitable for:** Tactical gear, military surplus collections, duty and police uniforms.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: sew the patch onto the upper arm or shoulder area of your uniform for a secure fit. The scudetto is designed as an arm/shoulder emblem (braccio omerale) and works well on jackets, field shirts, and camouflage uniforms.

In most cases, a straight stitch around the edge provides a stable attachment; a professional seamstress or uniform shop can finish it if you prefer. Use this patch when you need a low-profile, authentic unit emblem for outdoor duty, reenactment, or collection display.

Care and notes

Simple care keeps the patch looking its best while preserving the uniform.

- **Attachment:** Sew on securely; no velcro is supplied.
- **Washing:** Machine wash on a gentle cycle or hand wash to protect the embroidery.
- **Drying:** Air dry or low heat; avoid high-temperature dryers that can stress threads.
- **Availability:** Limited quantities are available due to demand.

FAQ



Q: Is this patch suitable for all uniforms?

A: Yes. It is designed for camouflage and can be adapted to other uniform types, including tactical and police uniforms. Placement may vary by service regulations.

Q: How do I attach the scudetto to my uniform?

A: The patch has no velcro and must be sewn on. A simple straight stitch around the edge is usually sufficient for a secure hold.

Q: Is the embroidery weather resistant?

A: The patch is made with durable embroidery meant to withstand normal outdoor conditions. Follow the care notes to maintain its appearance over time.

Q: What are the exact dimensions?

A: The patch measures 6.5 x 9 cm, a standard size for upper-arm or shoulder placement without being obtrusive.

Q: Can I buy more than one patch?

A: Yes, multiple patches can be purchased. Keep in mind stock is limited, so availability may change quickly.

Q: Is this an official military-issue item?
